• STEP 1: Book Myopia Consultation

A myopia management consultation costs £95. This, together with your NHS eye test will allow us to assess your child's suitability for various myopia management options and set benchmarks for success. The consultation involves measuring myopia, astigmatism, taking scans of the front and back of the eyes and assessing binocular vision. It is more in-depth than NHS eye test.

STEP 2: Dispense Lenses

If MiYOSMART lenses are suitable, you will see our Dispensing optician, who will guide you to select the correct frame for the lenses; you can also use your own frame if it is suitable for MiYOSMART lenses.

STEP 3: 1 month virtual up & 6 month in-practice follow-ups

We will see your child in 6 months' time following the eye test We will ask several questions to assess how your child is performing as well as carry out a full eye test including checking the myopia and astigmatism and the eye health. This follow up is more in depth than the NHS examination as it involves assessing binocular vision and focussing lag (a finding associated with myopia progression) and scans where necessary. These examinations are not part of the standard NHS sight test and is chargeable (£95)
